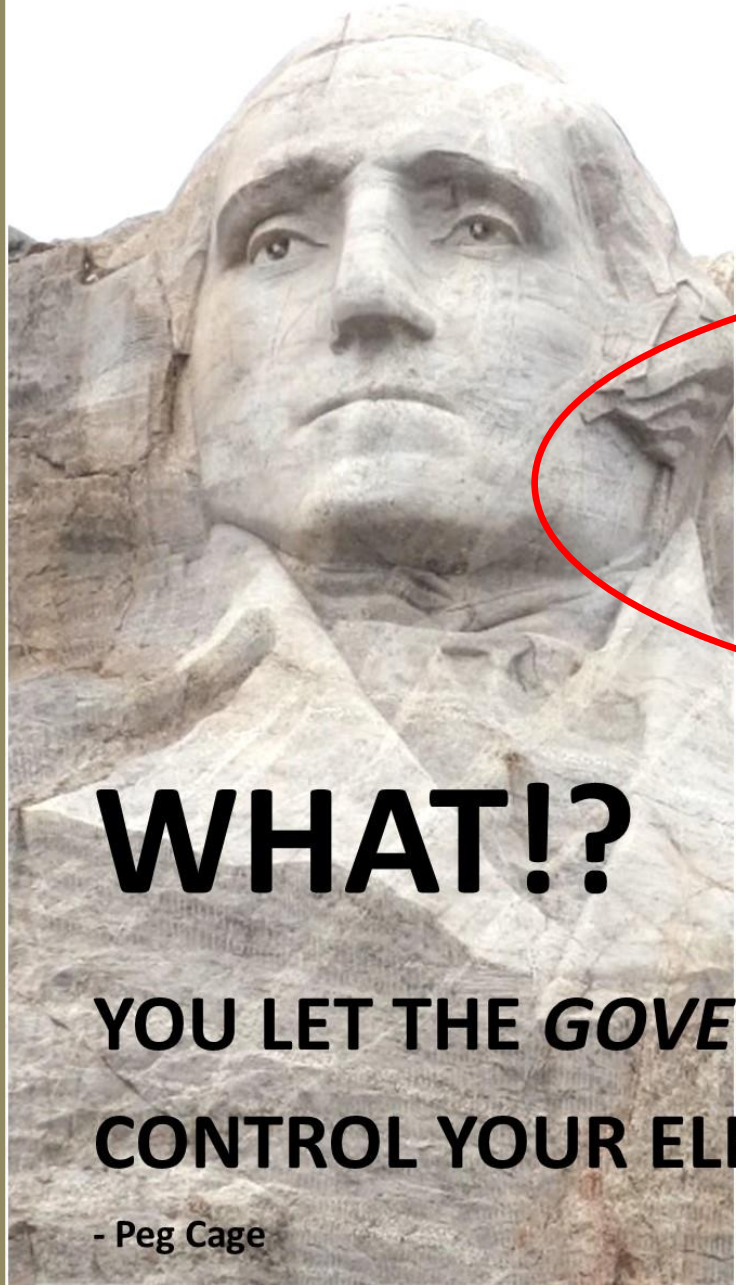

"The SOS is required to certify the elections based on the certifications sent from the Counties.

Canvass Boards are not required to certify if not satisfied that the voter's will has been determined by the election."

DESCRIPTION OF CERTIFYING AN ELECTION

The Canvass Board must approve:

- That the number of ballots counted does not exceed the number of ballots cast
- That the Statement of Vote submitted to the state, is a true and accurate listing of the results of the election

Canvass Board Duties

Among other numerous assigned canvass board duties in statute, C.R.S. 1-10-101.5 requires that we, as a Canvass Board,

- (a) Reconcile the ballots cast in an election to confirm that the number of ballots counted in that election does not exceed the number of ballots cast in that election,
- (b) Reconcile the ballots cast in each precinct in the county to confirm that the number of ballots cast does not exceed the number of registered electors in the precinct; and
- (c) Certify the abstract of votes cast in any election and transmit the certification to the secretary of state. A majority of Canvass Board members signatures shall be sufficient to certify the abstract of votes cast in any election. When unable to certify the abstract of votes by the majority of the Board for any reason, the Canvass Board shall transmit the noncertified abstract of votes to the secretary of state along with a written report detailing the reason for noncertification.

Certification of the Official Abstract under C.R.S. 1-10-101.5 is the critical exercise in finalizing the election process and requires far more than the subtraction of ballots counted from ballots cast and ballots cast from registered electors in each precinct. Such a trivial arithmetic exercise does not require thinking individuals for verification, and the Board's certification would be meaningless if it were limited to this exercise. There are, in fact, over 40 significant references to required activities of the Canvass Board in 18 sections of C.R.S. Title 1. One particularly instructive statute, 1-8-308, references the Canvass Board's Abstract as a separate document from the Official Abstract. Obviously, the Board is expected to build its own Abstract, and at some point it is expected that the Board's Abstract would be compared to the Official Abstract and any differences reconciled.

We have reviewed the oath we took as Canvass Board members and the numerous duties and responsibilities of the Canvass Board as detailed in Title 1. For the past several weeks we have been working toward the goal of certifying the recent general election. Our decision not to certify at this time without additional verifiable data is based upon our understanding of our legal and ethical obligations.

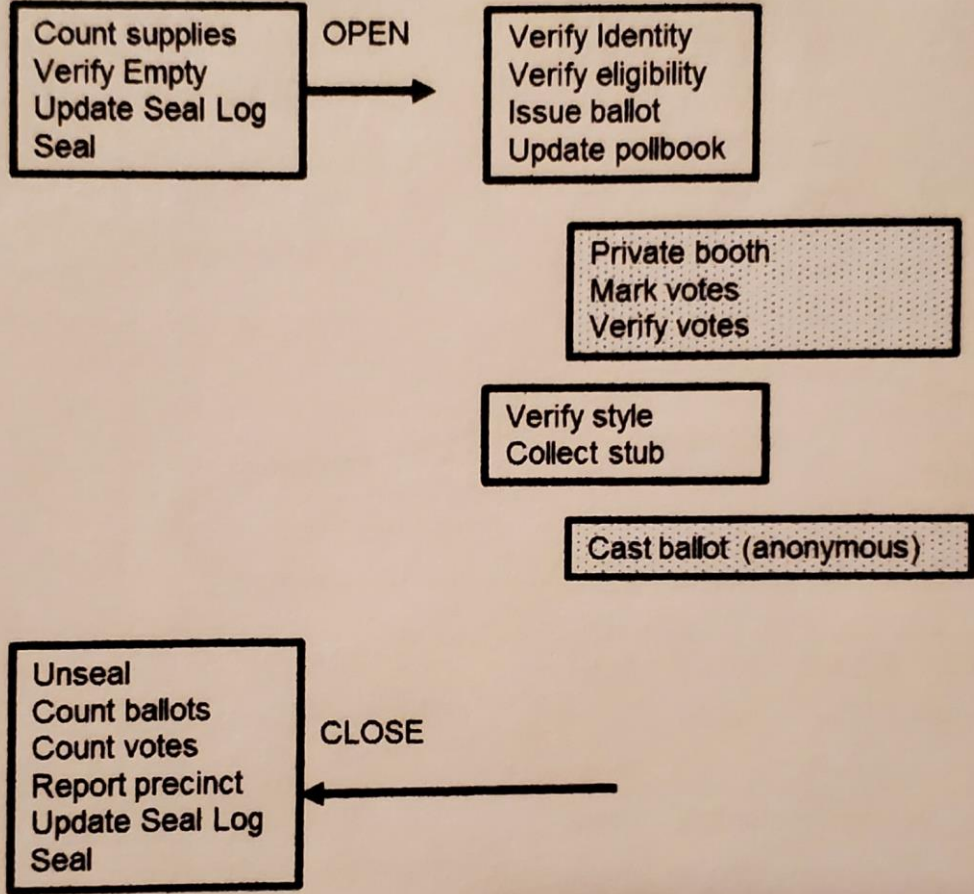
Issue – “Ballots Cast” from DESCRIPTION OF CERTIFYING AN ELECTION

“The number of ballots cast” is now defined by 8 CCR 1505-1 Rule 1.1.9 as *the number of ballots received by the County Clerk, excluding mail ballots returned by the post office as undeliverable.*

Rule 1 does not specify when a ballot is deemed to be received. This definition transfers the act of casting a ballot from something the voter did to something the clerk does.

The BCR Election Integrity Team unanimously agreed that this definition defies Colorado Revised Statute 2-4-101, Common and technical usage, which reads: Words and phrases shall be read in context and construed according to the rules of grammar and common usage. Words and phrases that have acquired a technical or particular meaning, whether by legislative definition or otherwise, shall be construed accordingly.

Remote voting

Colorado's remote-voting election system has sacrificed election security, accuracy, and transparency in favor of a system designed to maximize voter participation. Colorado's "modernized" system has

1. eliminated the ballot chain-of-custody protocols,
2. essentially eliminated voter identity and eligibility tests in favor of allowing anybody to vote, and
3. replaced the traditional system without first designing, testing, and certifying a complete remote voting system.

Election laws and the rules have not overcome the realities of distance and time. This chart does not include Fax, Email, Online, and In-Person voting.

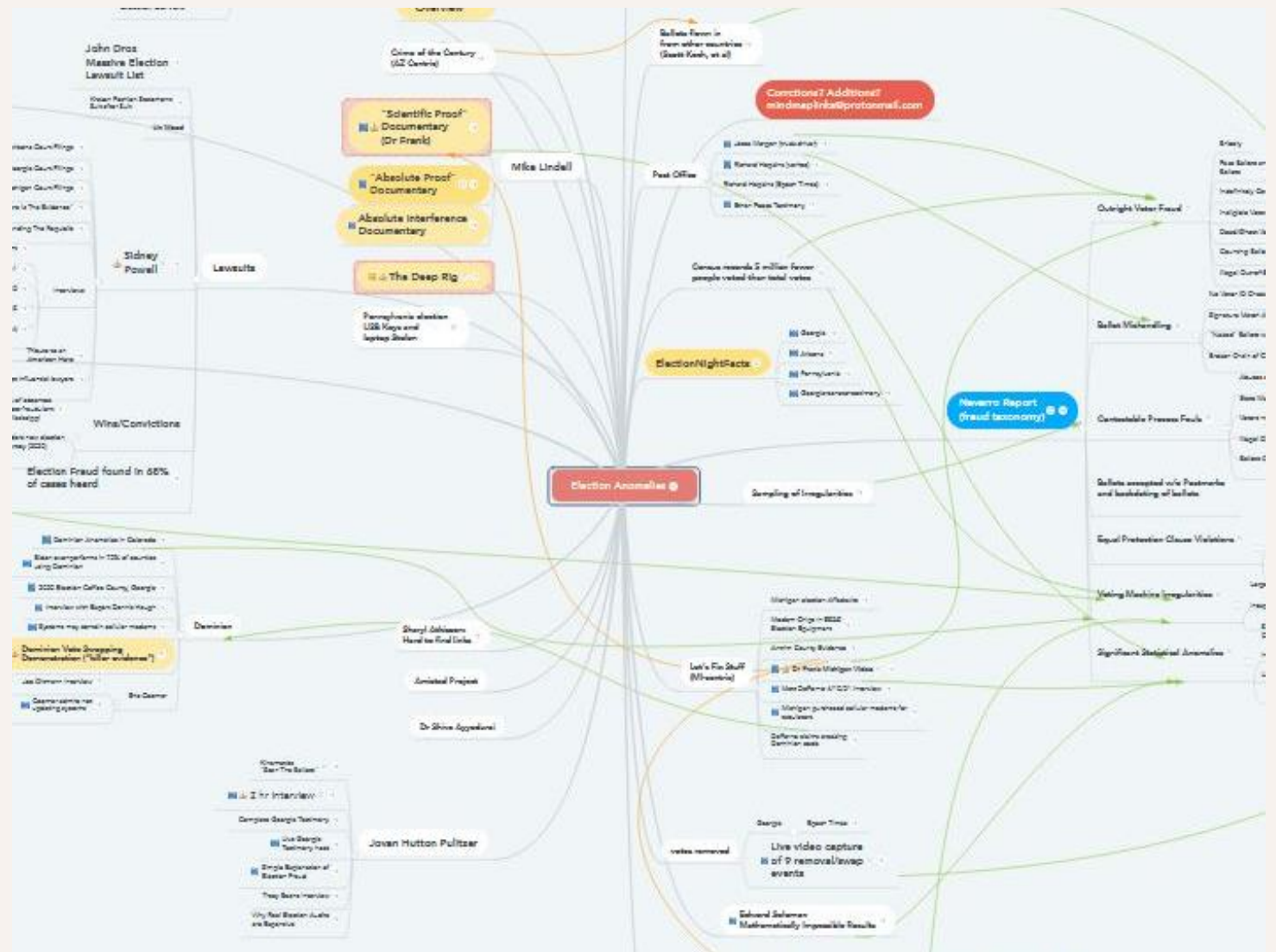

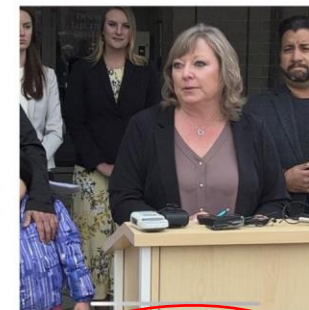

How are the election results checked after the votes are tallied?

After each Election Day, but before election results are certified, all Colorado counties conduct a Risk Limiting Audit to verify that the tabulation system counted ballots correctly. This audit includes bipartisan citizen audit boards comparing randomly selected voter-marked paper ballots against the electronic record of how the system counted those ballots. Colorado was the first state to conduct a statewide Risk Limiting Audit in 2017. These audits are now considered national best practices for ensuring voting system accuracy. Once the audit is complete, clerks convene a canvas board made up of citizens from their county to **check the results and validate voter turnout.** These canvass meetings are open to the public.

Smith “replies-all” to Crane’s false assertions

“These reports show that the certification of our voting systems and their use in Colorado elections has been in violation of Colorado law, and that the extraordinary vulnerability of the voting systems to penetration and manipulation, coupled with the wanton destruction of election records, means that neither the results reported from these systems nor the election officials who swear to their security and integrity, can be trusted by Colorado citizens. The safeguards in CRS Title 1, which the General Assembly has presumably intended and assumed would protect the purity of Colorado elections and safeguard the elective franchise, have failed - through the ignorance and deliberate subversion of sworn election officials, and with the mute inaction of Colorado’s sworn law enforcement officers, to Mr. Crane’s ardent applause.”

IF A MAJORITY OF A CANVASS BOARD IN A COUNTY IS UNABLE TO OR DOES NOT CERTIFY THE ABSTRACT OF VOTES FOR ANY REASON BY THE DEADLINE FOR THE COUNTY TO CERTIFY THE ABSTRACT OF VOTES, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL REVIEW THE NONCERTIFIED ABSTRACT OF VOTES AND WRITTEN REPORT PROVIDED BY THE CANVASS BOARD UNDER SECTION 1-10-101.5 (1)(c). IF, AFTER REVIEW, THE SECRETARY OF STATE DETERMINES THAT THE NONCERTIFIED ABSTRACT OF VOTES, ALONG WITH THE WRITTEN REPORT, OTHER INFORMATION AND FACTS OF THE CASE PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY, OR INFORMATION REVEALED UPON INVESTIGATION BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE IS CLEAR AND CONVINCING IN SHOWING HOW MANY VOTES WERE CAST FOR EACH CANDIDATE, BALLOT QUESTION, OR BALLOT ISSUE, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CERTIFY THE RESULTS FOR THE COUNTY AND PROCEED TO CERTIFYING STATE RESULTS UNDER SECTION 1-10-105. AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY DESIGNATE A REGISTERED ELECTOR OF THE STATE TO CARRY OUT THE DUTIES REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION.

SECTION 12. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 1-7-507, amend (6)

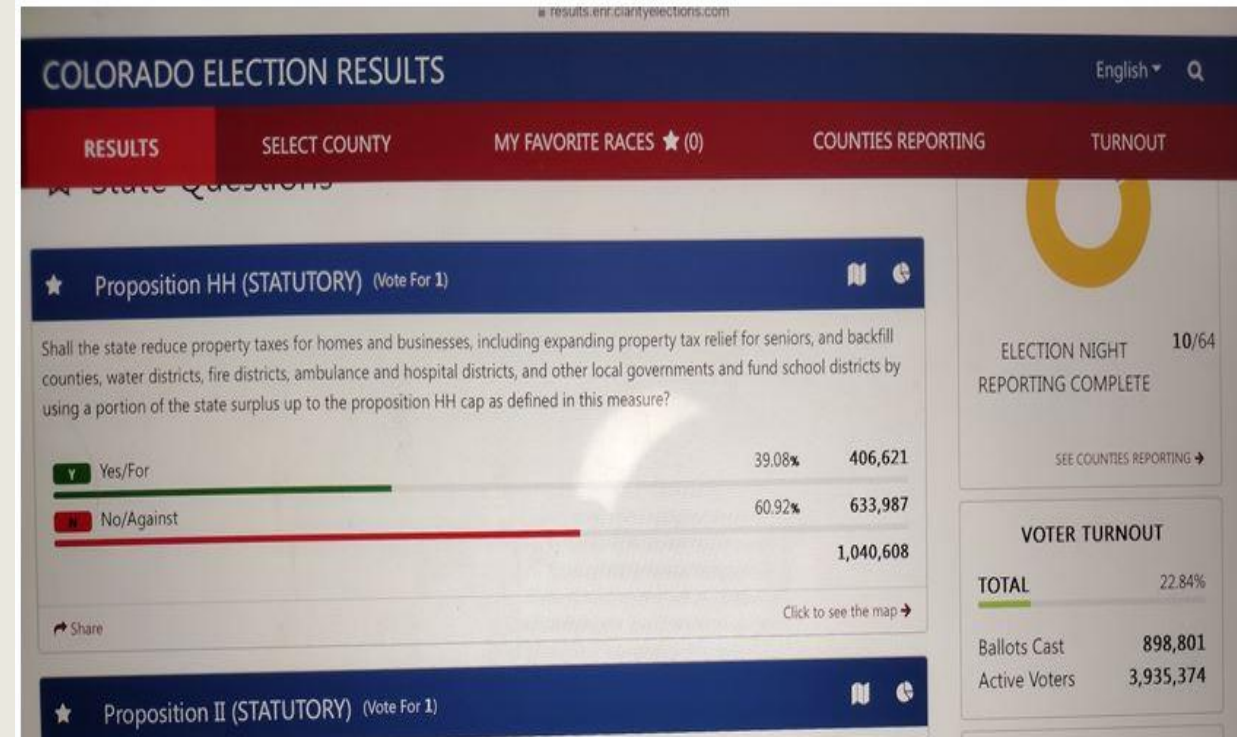
as follows:

1-7-507. Electronic vote-counting - procedure. (6) If A SOFTWARE OR HARDWARE MALFUNCTION MAKES IT IMPOSSIBLE TO COUNT ALL OR A PART OF THE BALLOTS WITH ELECTRONIC VOTE-TABULATING EQUIPMENT, THE SECRETARY OF STATE, AFTER

CONSULTATION WITH THE DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL, MAY PERMIT THE DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL TO DIRECT THAT SUCH BALLOTS **be counted manually**, following as far as practicable the provisions governing the counting of paper ballots as provided in 1-7-307.

Is this a problem?

In Conclusion...
